



Here are just some of the amazing new books that are available from the library:




How Dogs Work by Daniel Tatarsky and David Humphries

How to train a Superpup by Gwen Bailey


Full of important information to help guide you through having a dog. From choosing what is the right puppy for you to training your new best friend.



How to... Horse Riding by Caroline Stamps


A guide for beginners who are just starting out in the riding world. Contains practical advice and step by step photographs that show you everything you need to know.






Complete Horse Care Manual by Colin Vogel

Behind the Scenes at the Zoo by DK books



Full of amazing information and fun




Eyewitness Dinosaur by David Lambert

From meat-eaters to plant-eaters this book is full of brilliant illustrations and interesting information about these prehistoric creatures that once roamed the earth.



Beautiful illustrations showing off the biggest, scariest and weirdest animals that have ever walked or lived on our planet – The Dinosaurs.






## **GOAL!** By DK Books
