#### Year 3 Visit to Hook

This week Year 3 have thoroughly enjoyed their first outing at Hook Junior School to their local area of Hook. They began their trip by conducting a traffic survey along London Road counting all the vehicles, which passed by for a duration of 10 minutes. They then continued down London Road looking at the types and styles of buildings from residential to commercial to terrace to detached houses in addition to visiting the local church. Each child then completed an environmental quality survey of the centre of Hook and will analyse their data during their follow up geography lessons. On the way home, the children visited Wellworth Park to discuss the importance of green space in the local area. The children were exceptional role models for the school and loved their outdoor learning experience.

Finally... an event of this size needs a group of about 100 volunteers to make it both safe and successful - without our volunteers the event simply wouldn't be able to go ahead. If you are able to volunteer for any of the roles we have available on the night, please sign up - there are roles which still allow you to watch the fireworks with friends and family so that you don't miss out! 




