Fun Run

School Meal Prices

You may be aware that this week, Hampshire County Council announced that their catering services (HC3S) will be increasing the cost of pupil meals from £2.60 to £2.80. The charge for a pupil meal at Hook Junior School will remain £2.50 and we do not anticipate that this will change for the remainder of the school year unless the food supply chain is affected by exceptionally high price increases.

The NHS School Age Immunisation Team will be coming to school next Tuesday to administer flu immunisations to children.

Please ensure you have completed the online consent form by 8am Monday 17th October if you wish your child to be included.

The immunisation team will not be able to administer a vaccine to children with for whom consent has not been given before 8am on Monday 17 October.

Some parents have reported problems viewing homework in Seesaw when the task has been uploaded in Adobe PDF format. We understand that the Seesaw development team are aware of the issue and working on a solution.

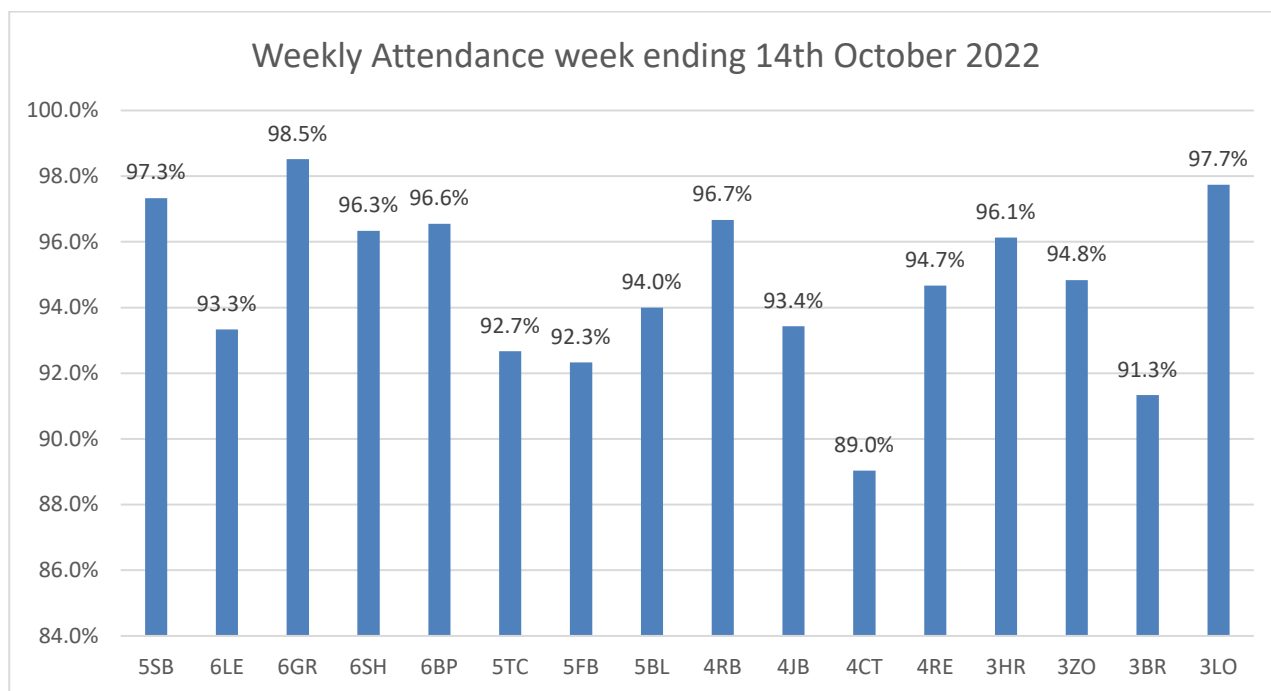


