They were fascinated to learn more about marine animals (especially the starfish which has 1000 feet and can pop its tummy out of its mouth to digest its food!); they thought about the uses of the seaside and searched for litter which wasn't blowing away. The trip really helped them put in context the current topic of 'Plastic Pollution' and we even spotted the RNLI lifeboats in training (just a day after our RNLI visit!). The Year 4 team were so impressed with the behaviour and maturity of the entire year group.
