### **Hampshire Games Handball**

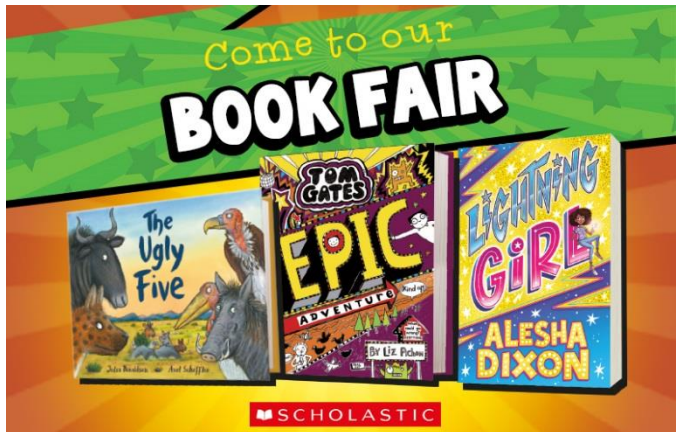

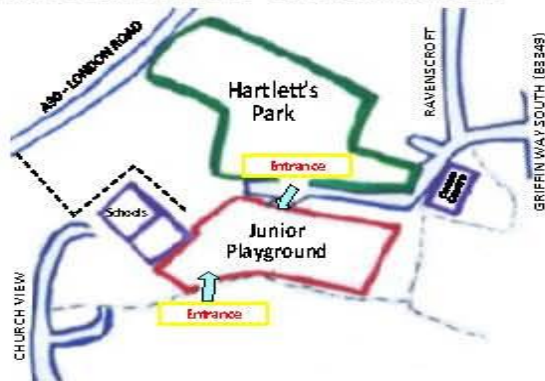
