### Think Safe: Thursday 11th July 2018, 8:50am – 12:00pm

The aim of the programme is to promote a stimulating educational experience which enables the children to learn about personal safety and gain increased confidence in themselves and their abilities within a realistic context. The objectives are:

- To learn in a safe environment
- To have practical experience of simulated situations
- To relate situations to everyday life
- To practice and develop safety skills
- To develop skills in hazard awareness and risk management.

The children will attend seven scenario-based workshops: fire; stranger danger; shop smart; road safety; water safety, antisocial behaviour and healthy relationships. This links into the PSHE (Personal Social Health Education) curriculum in Year 6 and teaching children how to keep and stay safe in order to safeguard themselves.

The event is free for the children and will provide invaluable information on keeping themselves safe, however we would please ask for a **voluntary contribution of £3.50 to cover the cost of transport**. We will be leaving school at 8:50am and returning at approximately 12.00pm. School lunches will take place as normal.

We require your permission to take your child off site, therefore please **sign and return the form at the end of the letter no later than Wednesday 10 July**.

We are seeking parent volunteers to support the Think Safe trip, travelling with pupils on the outward journey, remaining for the duration of the event and returning with the group afterwards. If you are able to assist, please indicate this on the reply slip.
