### Phase 2 Reopening

**A reminder that school is open only for pupils who are children of keyworkers, vulnerable children and children in year 6. Children may only attend when a place has been allocated and its availability confirmed to you by email.**

If you have not yet received confirmation of your child's place (in the form of a class number that they will join and accompanied by specific arrival / departure gate and times) please do not send your child to school.

We are doing our very best to accommodate requests for places for children who qualify to return. However, in order for us to maintain the necessary standards of safety and consistency for opening within current guidance, we are not able to accept children who arrive at school without having previously allocated to a class group.

Everyone who has contributed to the planning, coordination and opening of school is particularly grateful for the continued expressions of support we have been receiving.
