Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our exciting topic work linked to Darwin's theory of Evolution, Year 6 would like to invite you to join them for a Collaborative Learning Event on Friday 16th March at 1.15pm - 2.45pm.

The children have been learning about Darwin's finches. Darwin noticed how the finches on different Galapagos Islands showed variation; for example, their beaks were different depending on the local food source and concluded that because the islands were so distant from the mainland, the finches that had arrived there in the past had changed over time.

The children will design their own bird with particular adaptations which could enable it to live in a specified environment and, with your help, they will then create their bird using clay.

If you would like to join us for the afternoon, you will need to enter the school via the main school entrance at 1.15pm before making your way to the year 6 classrooms. At 2.45pm, we will tidy up and your child/children will meet you at the end of the school day on the playground. Old shirts or aprons are advisable, as working with clay can get messy!
