Daily reading at home

The importance of daily reading cannot be underestimated. Reading for a minimum of 20 minutes a day is said to significantly widen a child's vocabulary range, with noticeable benefits on their social and communication skills, not to mention the direct impact it has on their writing ability and spelling competence. By listening to and reading with your child daily, you can help develop their imagination, fluency and enthusiasm for reading. As a school, the expectation is for children to read for a minimum of 20 minutes each day and record this in their reading diaries, signed by an adult each day. In school every Friday, during our celebration assemblies, classes compete to win the Golden Book award which is awarded to the class which has the highest percentage of children in the class that have read daily and had their reading records signed. Children also receive raffle tickets for their reading and for keeping their reading records up to date. Winning raffle tickets are drawn during the assembly with books given as a prize. We would really appreciate your support in the on-going drive to promote reading at home and to help your children with the timely completion of their reading diaries.
